Suspension of the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program

To comply with the recent DBE Interim Final Rule published in the Federal Registry on October 3, 2025.

Effective immediately, DBE Contract Goal Setting, Counting, along with DBE monitoring and compliance, is suspended until further notice.

During the suspension, there will be:

- No contract goals
- No Good Faith Effort Evaluation
- No counting of DBE participation
- · No monitoring of DBE program compliance
- No DBE forms submission

Please contact your District Local Assistance Engineer or District DBE Coordinator for questions regarding your specific project in its current phase. As additional information becomes available Caltrans will issue further detailed instructions, host training sessions, and provide outreach to ensure all partners understand and comply with the new requirements.

In response to the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program (DBE) Interim Final Rule (IFR) published on October 3, 2025, the Caltrans Division of Local Assistance is issuing this Office Bulletin

The IFR, which addresses amendments to 49 CFR Parts 23 and 26 concerning the Airport Concessions DBE and DBE Program, was published in the Federal Register and became effective immediately
